PURPOSE

This fact sheet outlines when and how alcohol can be purchased and consumed by all performers and crew, other than City of Brampton staff, on the stage and in backstage areas of The Rose and on The Rose Patio. Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed onsite at LBP, Cyril Clark, or in Garden Square.

This information does not apply to The Rose main lobby, upper lobby and rotunda, as well as the Main Space seating areas, all of which are open to patrons, and where the sales, service and consumption of alcohol are regulated through the theatre bar.

THE ROSE MAIN STAGE

Alcoholic beverages may be consumed by performers and crew members during performances on The Rose Main Stage, only when necessary for purposes of an event, if the following criteria are met:

- All alcohol must be purchased from The Rose bar, and served open/uncorked by Food and Beverage staff or Artist Liaisons, and
- Any alcohol selections outside the current bar menu must be requested during show advancing, or by the Event Planning meeting, at the latest, and
- Any alcohol not purchased from The Rose bar is allowed in the facility only if it will remain unopened and sealed, and
- The approved artist rider includes a request for a performer or crew member to consume alcohol on stage during a performance, rehearsal and/or sound check, when necessary for purposes of an event, **or**
- The event involves theatre bar service to patrons on the stage

THE ROSE STUDIO & THE ROSE PATIO

Alcoholic beverages may be consumed by performers and crew members during performances in The Rose Studio or on The Rose Patio if the following criteria are met:

- All alcohol must be purchased from the theatre bar, and served open/uncorked by Food and Beverage staff or Artist Liaisons, and
- On The Rose Patio, alcoholic beverages must remain inside licensed/fenced area, and
- Any alcohol selections outside the current bar menu must be requested during show advancing, or by the Event Planning meeting, at the latest, and
- Any alcohol not purchased from theatre bar is allowed in the facility only if it will remain unopened and sealed.

THE ROSE BACKSTAGE & DRESSING ROOMS

Only performers and crew members may purchase alcohol from the theatre bar to bring onstage or backstage, if doing so is necessary for purposes of an event. All others with backstage access:

- May bring alcohol purchased at the theatre bar to the dressing room area
- May *not* bring alcohol purchased at the theatre bar backstage

ORDER REQUEST

If performers or rental clients would like to purchase alcohol that is not available at the theatre bar for consumption backstage or in the dressing room area, they must inform Technical Operations staff during show advancing, or the Venue Coordinator by the Event Planning meeting, at the latest.
