### **PURPOSE**

This fact sheet outlines when and how alcohol can be purchased and consumed by all performers and crew, other than City of Brampton staff, on the stage and in the backstage areas of The Rose, Lester B Pearson (LBP), and on The Rose Patio. Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed onsite at Cyril Clark, or in Garden Square.

This information does not apply to the following areas, all of which are open to patrons, and where the sales, service and consumption of alcohol are regulated by the Performing Arts Food and Beverage department:

- The Rose main lobby, upper lobby and rotunda
- The Rose main space seating areas
- LBP lobby (licenced area within temporary stanchions)
- LBP main space seating areas and LBP Studio

### **REQUIREMENTS**

Alcoholic beverages may be consumed by performers and crew, during performances at The Rose and LBP, if the performer(s)/crew deem it necessary for purposes of the event/performance, and if the following criteria are met:

- All alcohol must be purchased from the theatre bar, and served open/uncorked by Food and Beverage or Artist Services staff
- Any alcohol selections outside the current bar menu must be requested during show advancing, or by the Event Planning meeting, at the latest
- Any alcohol not purchased from the theatre bar is allowed in the facility only for the purposes of transporting it, and if it remains unopened and sealed while in the facility
- On The Rose Patio, alcoholic beverages must remain inside licensed/fenced area

If alcohol will be consumed onstage/backstage during Community & Commercial Presentations, an Artist Liaison must be requested during the event planning process, at the organizer's expense.

### **DRESSING ROOMS & GREEN ROOM**

Alcohol may be consumed in the Green Room and dressing rooms, but must be purchased at the theatre bar.

### **ORDER REQUEST**

If performers or Community & Commercial Presenters would like to purchase alcohol that is not available at the theatre bar for consumption backstage or in the dressing room area, they must inform Technical Operations staff during show advancing, or the Venue Coordinator by the Event Planning meeting, at the latest.
